Should the Collection of Working Papers include some of the notes prepared by the Rapporteurs, e.g. "The Werner Report revisited" (CSEMU/1/88); "Economic and monetary union: The main issues" (CSEMU/2/88); and an edited version of "The ECU, the common currency and the Monetary Union" (CSEMU/1/89)? Should the paper by Daniel Gros ("Alternative Paradigms for Monetary Union"), which was circulated to the Committee, be included?
