#### SWIFT ISO 20022 Migration

- No Big Bang approach
- Parallel timeline to T2 / T2S Consolidation
- Plan for co-existence phase (2021-2025) required







#### T2 / T2S Consolidation


- Advanced project phase with expected readiness reporting in October 2020
- Start of external testing scheduled very late in March 2021

Eurosystem Collateral Management System

- Go Live in November 2022
- First documentation published on January 7th 2020



#### Payment order cancellation

New automated process (based on RTGS UDFS V2.1)

- RTGS Account Holder A sends a camt.056 to request the recall of an already settled payment.
- 2. RTGS forwards it to RTGS Account Holder B
- RTGS sends a camt.029 (optional) to the RTGS Account Holder A to inform of the forwarding
- 4. RTGS Account Holder B checks (outside of RTGS) the requested recall.
- 5. RTGS Account Holder B sends a pacs.004
- 6. RTGS validates and settles the payment return on the RTGS DCAs of RTGS Account Holders A and B.
- 7. RTGS sends a positive pacs.002 (optional) to the RTGS Account Holder B
- 8. RTGS creates the pacs.004 to RTGS Account Holder A.



## Intraday Liquidity Management

Manage related flows based on CLM UDFS V2.1

- A camt.050 is sent from a CLM Account Holder to CLM to initiate a Liquidity transfer
- 2. Settlement on MCAs (MCA to dedicated transit account)
- 3. A camt.050 is forwarded to RTGS
- Settlement on RTGS DCAs (dedicated transit account in RTGS to RTGS DCA)
- 5. A camt.054 is sent by RTGS to the RTGS Account Holder (optional)
- 6. A camt.025 generated in RTGS is sent to CLM
- 7. A camt.025 is sent by CLM to the CLM Account Holder




