Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

With T2S CR T2S-383-URD, the possibility to submit already matched cross-CSD settlement instructions is introduced in T2S.

- A T2S Actor located in one CSD would have the option to instruct an already matched instruction where the counterparty is located in a different T2S CSD.
- The counterparty, and the CSD of the counterparty would be informed about such already matched cross-CSD instructions via a sese.023 copy message.

According to current T2S Business Rules:

- it is mandatory to provide the party details (Party BIC and CSD BIC) of the counterparty in a settlement instruction,
- however, the own party details can be left blank.

Now, if the instructing party decides to leave the own party details blank, then this information would also be missing in the sese.023 copy received by the counterparty / the counterparty CSD. This would create a situation where an instruction is informed against an account of the counterparty, but without providing the complete information about the party that instructed the already matched cross-CSD instruction (and which would be the counterparty to the counterparty).

This should be avoided by additional business rules on T2S to ensure that in already matched cross-CSD instructions own party details (Party BIC and Party CSD) are always provided.

Description of requested change:

Two new Business Rules should be introduced to ensure that already matched cross-CSD instructions always contain own party data:

- If the instruction is an already matched cross-CSD delivery, then DeliveringDepository and DeliveringParty1 must be present.
- If the instruction is an already matched cross-CSD receive, then ReceivingDepository and ReceivingParty1 must be present.

3.3.8.4.3The message in business context

Message example: sese.023.001._T2S_AlreadyMatched-Cross CSD_Example.xml

In this example, a settlement instruction cross CSD that has already been matched is sent requesting a debit of securities versus a credit of cash.

The T2S party, CSD Participant A (PRTAFRPPXXX) belonging to the CSD C (CSDCBIC1XXX) with a securities account '1000000123' in T2S has instructed, with 'normal' priority, the delivery of 100000 securities, ISIN00000001, to the securities account '1000000234', held by counterparty Participant B (PRTBBIC1XXX) belonging to CSD D (CSDDBIC1XXX) versus a payment of 234056 Euros for settlement on the 3/9/2021. CSD C Participant A's dedicated cash account is '9000000123' while CSD D Participant B's is '9000000234'. Instructing party information is provided within the BAH which is not provided in the example.

Summary of functional, development, infrastructure and migration impacts

LCMM:

Validation Process

The CR-383 allows participants to send already matched settlement instructions in cross-CSD scenarios. As relevant information related to the CSD BIC and the party BIC of the leg being instructed is not mandatory (i.e. only the counterparty party data is mandatory), if this information is not included in the sese.023, the counterparty CSD, in a cross-CSD scenario, cannot identify who are the Party and Party CSD.

LCMM validation process needs to be enhanced to reject cross-CSD already matched instructions where the own party data (i.e. own Party and Party CSD information) is missing.

Currently, only the counterparty party data is mandatory in cross-CSD already matched instructions. This CR includes the own party data as mandatory for already matched settlement instructions in cross-CSD scenario. In particular, with this CR, the following fields will be mandatory:

- If the instruction is an already matched cross-CSD delivery, then DeliveringDepository and DeliveringParty1 must be present.
- If the instruction is an already matched cross-CSD receive, then ReceivingDepository and ReceivingParty1 must be present.

To ensure that this data is fulfilled, new consistency validations need to be included, to reject the instructions that do not pass the abovementioned validations. For that, new business rules are drafted.

Main Cost Drivers:

Update the validation process to ensure that, in already matched Settlement Instructions in Cross-CSD scenarios, own party fields (Party BIC and Depository BIC) are mandatory.

 Testing of the validation process to check that already matched Settlement Instructions in Cross-CSD scenarios are correctly accepted or rejected depending on how the fields own Party BIC and own Depository BIC are informed.
